CTIEMT enters into an MoU with research faculty from the University of the West Indies to promote research innovation



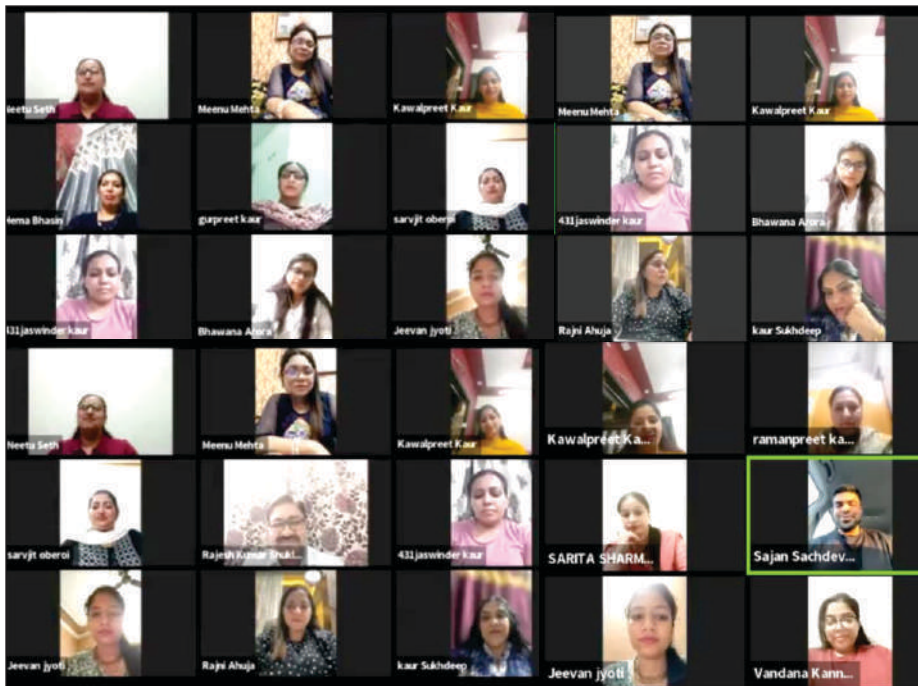

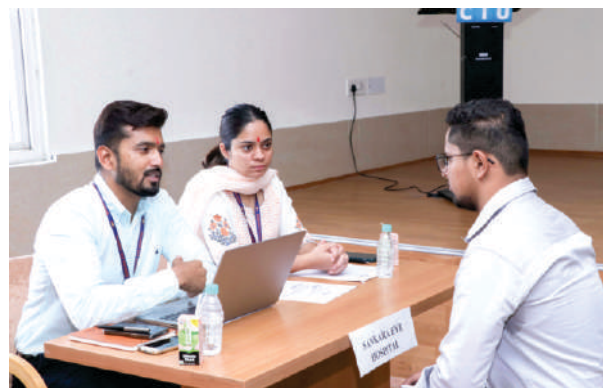
